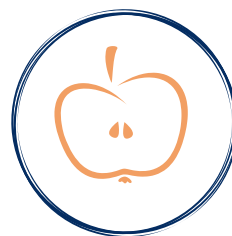

The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas distributes food to 140 partner agencies & programs throughout 12 counties.

The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas serves 17 senior centers in 12 counties. 1 in 5 seniors in NEA are at risk of hunger.

The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas' Fresh Produce Program provides healthy fruits and vegetables to people facing hunger.

The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas distributes 1,111 backpacks each week of the school year. The cost of each backpack is \$4.17.

Through mobile food pantries, the Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas provides USDA Commodity foods to 10,000 people each month.

Speak up for what you believe in! Use social media platforms to spread the message of what the Food Bank is doing.

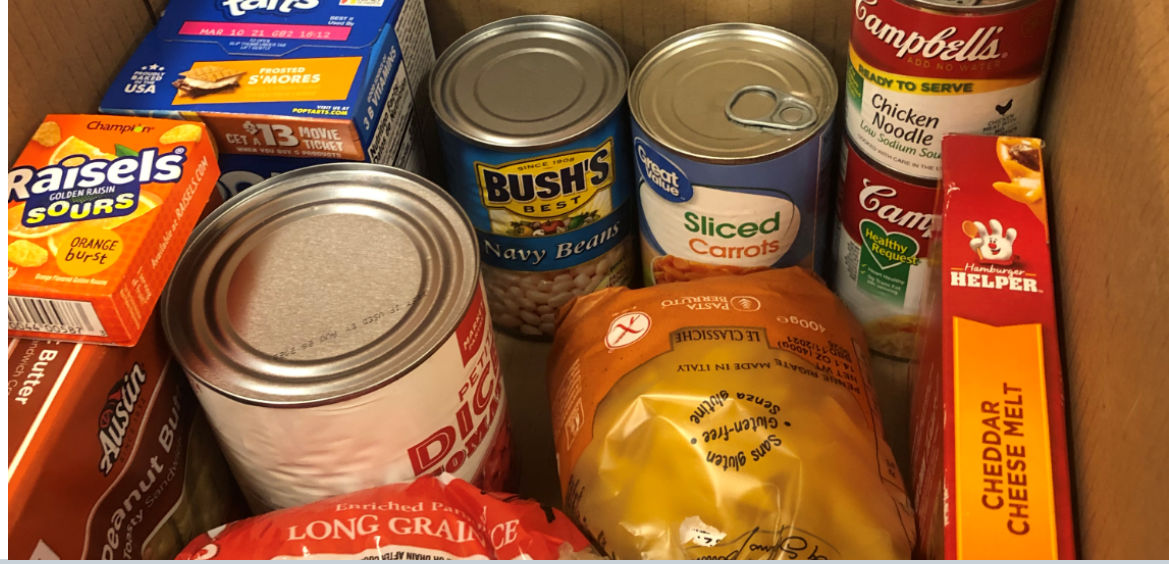

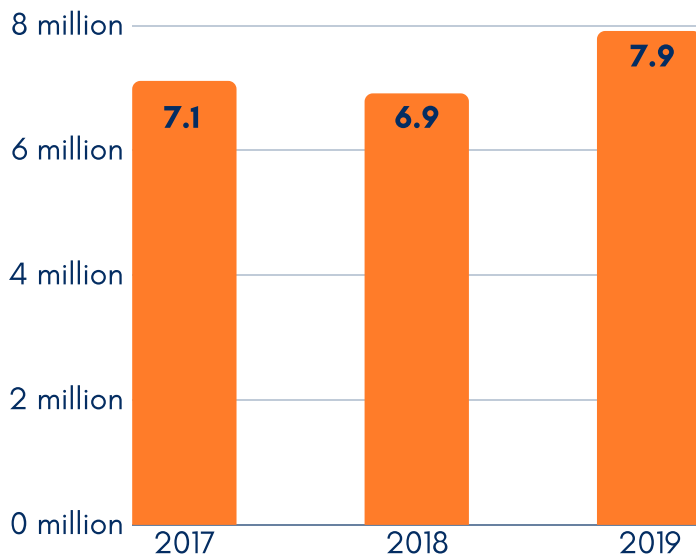

## FOOD DISTRIBUTION (IN LBS)



In 2019, the Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas was able to distribute 7.9 million pounds of food to those in need in Northeast Arkansas. For every \$1 raised, the Food Bank is able to help provide up to 4 meals.

The Food Bank of Northeast Arkansas relies on volunteers throughout the year to pack food boxes and sort food donations. Without volunteers, Food Bank staff wouldn't be able to keep up with the demand. In 2019, the Food Bank had 2,119 volunteers who donated 6,679 hours.
